Commercial Access Policy

Effective: December 1, 2001 Revised: 11/18/2023

#### **DeBORDIEU®**

The DCCA requires all Contractors and Vendors entering DeBordieu Colony to register with the DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department. Each vehicle must obtain the appropriate pass before entering DeBordieu Colony for commercial purposes. The DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department tracks each vehicle by the license plate number or barcode number if applicable and monitors vehicles while inside the community for adherence to the DCCA rules and regulations.

#### I. Fee Schedule

### **II. Requirements & Restrictions**

The Following Documents are REQUIRED to Purchase or Renew any DCCA Pass, Swipe Card or Decal/Barcode: <u>Current U.S. Driver's License</u>, <u>Current Vehicle</u> Registration, and <u>Current Proof of Insurance</u>.

Use of a property owner guest pass for commercial entrance to DeBordieu is prohibited.

Commercial work hours are limited to 7 AM through 6 PM, Monday through Friday. All workers must leave DeBordieu Colony by 6 PM. DeBordieu Management must authorize exceptions by 4 PM for that day. A request must be made by 4 PM the previous workday for permission to work on a non-workday, such as Saturdays or Holidays. Entrance to DeBordieu Colony is limited to the hours of 9 AM to 6 PM on these days. Any such work must be interior or non-noise work.

When entering or leaving DeBordieu Colony all workers are required to use the most direct route to and from their assigned job site. A commercial pass does not allow access to the community on days not working, nor does it permit a commercial vehicle to remain in DeBordieu after authorized hours, or for reasons unrelated to work being done.

All passes, swipe card and decals/barcodes are issued to one specific vehicle; transference to another vehicle is strictly prohibited. If the vehicle is sold, damaged or requires a new windshield the decal/barcode must be removed from the vehicle and returned to DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department before a new decal/barcode can be issued at no charge. There will be a \$20.00 additional fee to replace any pass or decal/barcode that is not returned or needs to be reactivated due to confiscation or termination by the DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department.

All commercial passes, swipe cards and decals/barcodes are the property of the DCCA. The DCCA reserves the right to deny the issuance of a decal, pass or to remove a decal or pass if it is not used in accordance with the rules and regulations of the DCCA.

General contractors are required to provide updated lists of employees and subcontractors to the DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department. Vehicles must be registered in the company's name or proof of employment to the contractor company must be verified. General contractors are required to collect all passes/decals of employees whose jobs are completed or upon their separation and return them to the DeBordieu Community Safety & Security Department.

## **III. Commercial Fee Exemptions**

DeBordieu Community Safety Department has listed certain commercial vehicles that are exempt from the fees in the policy for the benefit of property owners.

- Utilities (electric, telephone, water/sewer and cable-to include HTC, Frontier, Time Warner, Direct TV & Dish Network)
- Government Agencies
- Employees of the DCCA, DeBordieu Rentals and the DeBordieu Club while working for that entity

The following passes require prior authorization by the property owner before a pass can be issued:

- Estimates
- Deliveries to property owners or guests (deliveries to contractors need to purchase a pass)
  - > Pine straw deliveries only are exempt; unless they are spreading the pine straw then they will be required to purchase the necessary pass.
- Single home housekeepers, caregivers & babysitters
  - Babysitters/Petsitters/Housesitters need to have a pass called in for them and are not charged. If they desire a more expedient access system, because they sit for multiple families, advise them that they can contact administration. They are eligible to purchase an annual paper pass with a swipe card as an alternative to obtaining a daily pass each time they come on property.
- Religious organization representatives
- Medical professionals (nurses, home health, hospice, doctors)
- Moving Companies, whether coming in to do work or for an estimate
- Charities (Goodwill, Salvation Army, Habitat for Humanity, Churches)
- Taxi cabs, limousines & tow trucks
- Insurance Related (e.g. Insurance Adjuster)
- Appraisers
- Bank or Mortgage Related Inspections or Appraisals (e.g. Including anyone related to mortgage insurance and construction inspections)
